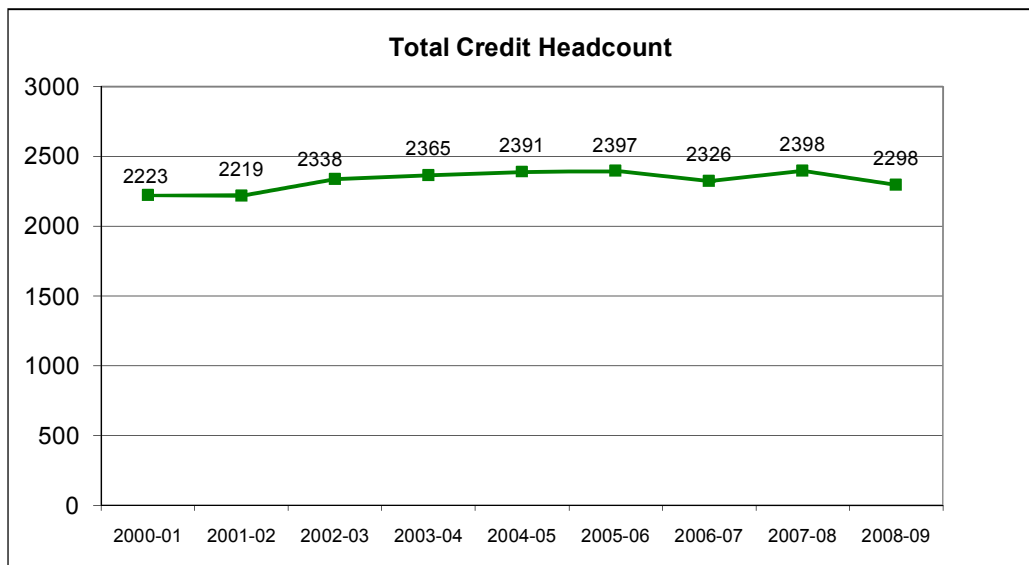

Students are counted by "classification" as of the start of the Fall semester each year. By this we mean that students who earn too few credits to advance to the next class are counted in the previous class. For example, the number of "freshmen" is larger than the number of entering first-year students because it includes second-year students who did not earn enough credits to be advanced to "sophomore" status.
