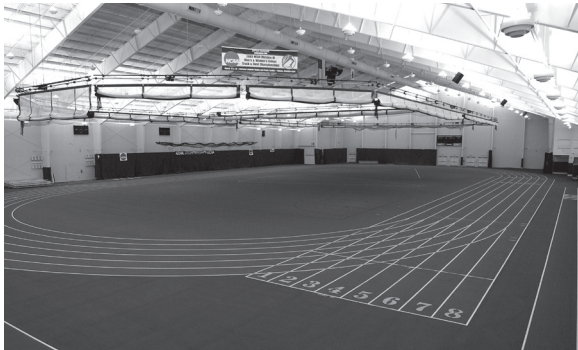


## CAMP SITE

The Winter Baseball Clinic will be held at DePauw's Indoor Tennis and Track Center Jan. 14-15, 2011. The site of all of DePauw baseball's indoor practice, the 132,500-square-foot indoor center also provides a state-of-the-art competition and practice venue for several of DePauw's athletic teams. As one of the elite athletic facilities in Indiana, it has twice served as the host site for the NCAA Division III national indoor track championships.

The facility allows nearly limitless baseball use. The physical space of the indoor track provides a full regulation size infield and outfield, including ample space for long toss and conditioning. In addition, the facility contains:

- two drop-down, 70-foot batting cages;
- four astro-turf bullpen mounds;
- six sock nets for tee work and hitting drills.

## CAMP STAFF

### **JAKE MARTIN, head coach**

Jake Martin begins his third year as head coach at DePauw, after serving six previous years as the Tigers' top assistant. In his first year at the helm, Martin led the team to 26 wins and a second-place finish in the Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference tournament, the Tigers' highest finish since 2001. Under Martin's lead in 2010, the team set the school record for doubles and shattered the school's single season fielding percentage mark (.968) which was good for 11th in the country. Last season, the Tigers earned a second seed in the conference tournament and finished fourth in the final SCAC standings.

In his six years as an assistant with the Tigers, the program posted an overall record of 185-104, including a 68-27 mark in conference play. The team broke the school's all-time win record (35 wins in 2008) three times and averaged 27 wins per season during that span. As the team's hitting and base running instructor, Martin helped the Tiger offense rewrite the program's record book. They set single-season records for stolen bases, runs scored, home runs, RBIs and total bases, while the 2004 and 2008 offenses posted the second and third highest batting averages in school history.

The Wabash College graduate played center field and pitched for the Little Giants, earning four varsity letters. Martin received all-conference honors as a pitcher and outfielder and was named team MVP in 2001 and 2003. The Milroy, Ind., native earned a master's degree from Indiana State University. Martin, his wife, Katie, and daughter, Madison, reside in Plainfield, Ind.

### **P.J. MITCHELL, assistant coach**

P.J. Mitchell enters his sixth year as the Tigers' pitching coach. In his five years at DePauw, the Tigers have placed four pitchers on the all-SCAC first team, three on the all-Mideast region team, and have won two SCAC Pitcher of the Year Awards. Mitchell's staffs have led the SCAC in ERA (15th in country in 2008) and strikeouts (12th in country in 2010), while walking the fewest batters in the conference twice (3rd in country in 2008).

Mitchell, a 2006 graduate of DePauw, earned four varsity letters, was named to the NCAA Mideast all-region team in 2004 and was a three time all-conference performer. He holds the program's records for innings pitched and appearances, and he is the school's single season and career strikeout leader.

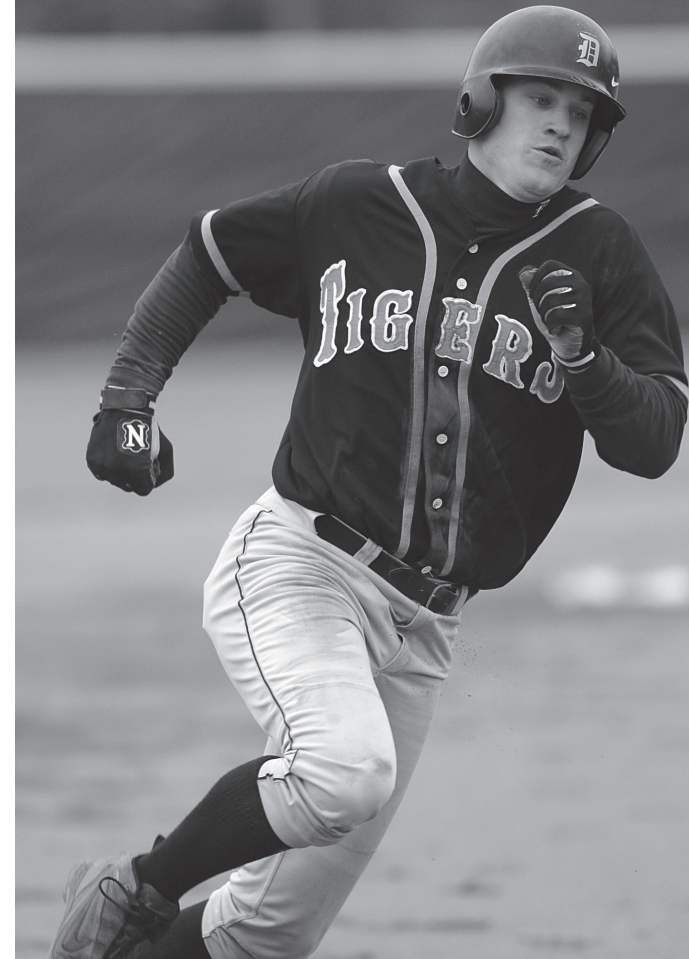
### **MATT PUSTAY, assistant coach**

Matt Pustay enters his second year as an assistant coach for the Tigers. The 2009 DePauw grad was the Tiger's co-captain his senior year, earned three varsity letters. Pustay comes back to DePauw after spending a year at Capital University in Columbus, Ohio, where he worked primarily with the catchers and hitters.

### **SAM LINETTE, assistant coach and strength and conditioning coordinator**

Sam Linette is returning to DePauw after spending last season as an assistant strength and conditioning coordinator for Wofford College. Linette will work primarily with hitters and is responsible for implementing strength, speed and agility programming for baseball. As a USAW Level 1 Performance Coach through USA Weightlifting, Linette coordinates the DePauw baseball weightlifting program, while also providing speed and agility instruction for all of the university's athletes through the performance enhancement series.

Directions: If traveling from the north, take U.S.  
231 south through downtown (turns  
into Jackson Street). Stay on Jackson  
Street; turn right on Hannah Street.  
The facility is immediately west of  
the football field.

If coming from the south, take U.S.  
231 north to Hannah Street. Turn  
left on Hannah Street; stay straight  
on Hannah Street through campus  
and across Jackson Street. The  
facility is immediately west of the  
football field.

## CAMP ORGANIZATION

The winter clinic sessions will offer pitchers and  
position players an opportunity to train at a college  
level for the day. The players will receive instruction in  
all aspects of the game, including:

- hitting (for position players);
- defensive drill work;
- team defense;
- base running;
- pitching mechanics/advanced pitching techniques;
- strength and conditioning/armcare.

Each player will have an opportunity to receive small  
group instruction with a camper-coach ratio of no  
greater than 8:1. Additionally, players will each go  
through a 45-minute strength and conditioning/  
speed and agility session.
