Tigers face Maroons in non-conference battle

DePauw steps back out of Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference play as it travels to the University of Chicago. DePauw is 2-2 after last week's heartbreaking 29-28 loss to nationally-ranked Trinity. Chicago is 1-2 after last Saturday's 31-13 defeat to Illinois Wesleyan.

SCOUTING CHICAGO

In the last week's game, the Maroons limited Illinois Wesleyan to just 325 yards, but committed four turnovers and were sacked 12 times. The Maroons opened the season with a 40-20 home win over North Park before losing at Elmhurst by a 39-27 count.

Phil Marino and Marc Zera have split time at quarterback with each posting a completion percentage of over 50 percent and an efficiency rating of greater than 124. The Maroons rank 17th in Division III with over 287 passing yards per contest. Frank Brown paces the rushing attack with just over 70 yards per game, while Micah Dawson is the team's top receiver with 20 catches, four touchdowns and 17.9 yards per catch. He ranks 11th in the nation with 119 receiving yards per game and 28th with 6.7 receptions per contest.

Defensively, Gabriel Fernandez leads the team with 26 tackles, while Steve Glomski has 24. Glomski ranks 29th in the nation with 7.0 solo tackles per game. Rob Tamillow and Matt Armbruster each have 4.5 tackles for loss with Glomski and Armbruster sharing the team lead with two sacks. Tamillow is the team leader with four pass breakups.

LAST YEAR'S MEETING

DePauw totaled 505 yards of offense with 253 on the ground and 252 through the air and the defense limited visiting Chicago to just 197 total yards on the way to a 51-10 win over the Maroons.

The Tigers controlled the ball for over 38 minutes, established a season-high of 253 rushing yards and were just one yard off of equaling the season's best total offense mark. Jackson Rust finished with 91 yards on 15 carries, while Matt King added 82 on 15 attempts. Sam Owens paced the Maroons with 42 yards in 10 tries.

Andy Yoder completed 10 of 13 passes for 192 yards and one touchdown while Ross Wiethoff added six-of-nine for 60 yards. Tony Pulice completed 15 of 32 passes for 104 yards for Chicago.

Jamarus Shephard caught six passes for 70 yards to lead the Tigers while Brian Culp had five for 88 yards. Jim Raptis led Chicago with nine catches for 81 yards.

Aaron Key paced DePauw with eight tackles, with Luis Davila and Jonathan Tatum each recording sacks. Curran Clark and Justin Tillis each had one interception. T.J. Rajcevic finished with 12 tackles for Chicago, while Nathan Hines added seven and an interception. Robert Tamillow had the Maroons' only sack of the afternoon.

LYNCH JUST THE NINTH DEPAUW COACH SINCE 1930

This game marks the fifth of Bill Lynch's DePauw career as just the ninth DePauw football coach since 1930. Lynch took over in December for the retired Nick Mourouzis who directed the Tigers to a 138-87-4 mark in 23 seasons.

Lynch was the head coach at Butler from 1985 through 1989 and compiled a 36-12-3 record. The Bulldogs won four conference titles and advanced to the NCAA Division II playoffs in 1988. He was the head coach at Division I Ball State from 1995 through 2002 and his 1996 team won the Mid-American Conference championship and earned a Las Vegas Bowl appearance. The Cardinals also won the MAC West Division co-title in 2001. His final three teams at Ball State were recognized by the American Football Coaches for outstanding graduation rates.

DEPAUW IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

In Division III statistics released earlier this week, DePauw's Jamarus Shephard ranks 30th with a kickoff return average of 27.6 yards. He finished second in the nation last year. Ross Wiethoff is 34th in the country in passing efficiency with a 146.3 rating. The Tigers are 28th in

the nation in rushing offense with an average of 231.5 yards per game.

EVERYBODY'S ALL-AMERICAN

Senior wide receiver and kick returner **Jamarcus Shephard** was selected to every all-America team as a kick returner at the conclusion of last season and was again a consensus preseason all-America pick. Shephard was a Division III first team selection by D3football.com, *Lindy's* and *Street & Smith* as well as a second team choice by *Football Gazette*. Shephard returned 19 kickoffs last season for an average of 34.7 yards including a pair of touchdowns against Millsaps. His average ranked second in Division III. In all, he finished with four returns of 74 or more yards last year and has returned three kickoffs for scores in his career.

TIGERS ESTABLISH GROUND GAME

The 'Tigers' 388 rushing yards against Hope were the third most in school history and the most since they had 389 at Rhodes on September 5, 1998. The school record is 532 yards against Principia on October 11, 1975. The Tigers' 60 rushing attempts were their most since they had 60 against Blackburn on October 13, 2001. The last time they had more attempts in a game was on November 14, 1998, when they totaled 64 against Wabash.

TWO TOP 100 YARDS

Ross Wiethoff and Jeremiah Marks each topped the 100-yard rushing plateau in the Hope win marking the first time for such a DePauw feat since Matt King (199 yards) and Jackson Rust (116) did so against Blackburn on October 13, 2001. Marks is just the fourth DePauw player to rush over for 100 yards in two different games as a freshman. Tom Campbell (1955) and Johnathon Stigall (1995) each did it three times, while Sam Juarascio (1972) did it once. Wiethoff has now topped the 100-yard mark twice in his career.

CHASING RECORDS

Jamarcus Shephard broke the DePauw career record for kickoff return yards in the Hope win and now has 1,306 on 45 returns for an average of 29.0 yards per return. Shephard's 3,344 career all-purpose yards rank fifth in school history and he needs 74 to pass Tim Weaver (1982-86) and 99 to pass John Stephens (1999-02). Terry Dickey (1988-91) is the all-time leader with 5,240.

Shephard enters the game with 138 career pass receptions which ranks seventh in school history. He needs two to pass Weaver and six to move ahead of Stephens. Jay True (1977-80) is the all-time leader with 195. Shephard's 1,853 receiving yards rank sixth in school history and he needs nine to pass Joe Schoen (1997-00) and 54 to pass Weaver. Dan Ryan (1999-02) is the all-time leader with 2,913.

TIGER NOTES

Jamarcus Shephard has caught at least one pass in each of his last 24 games, while Brian Culp has hauled in at least one in each of his last 14 ... quarterback Ross Wiethoff needs just three rushing yards to become only the 22nd player in DePauw history to rush for 1,000 career yards and just the third in school history to reach 1,000 rushing and passing yards. Sam Juarascio rushed for 2,171 and threw for 1,598 from 1972-75 and Eric Lortz rushed for 1,045 and threw for 1,621 from 1965-67 ... when running back Jeremiah Marks rushed for 104 yards in the opening win at Rhodes he was the first player in DePauw history to top the 100-yard mark in his first game as a freshman ... Marks' 83-yard touchdown run against Rhodes was the longest run from scrimmage by a DePauw player since Terry Dickey's 85-yard scamper in 1990 ... the Tigers have scored 42 points in the second quarter this year and just seven in the first ... DePauw's defense is holding opponents to 391.5 yards and 20.0 points per game as compared to last year at 429.8 yards and 24.5 points through four games.
