Tigers and Lynx kick off 2004 SCAC football season

Not only do Rhodes and DePauw open their respective football seasons against one another, but they also kick off the 2004 Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference schedule when they do battle at Fargason Field in Memphis.

For the seventh and final time since DePauw began play in the SCAC in 1998 the teams will play on the opening weekend. Beginning next season the game will be moved to the middle of October.

LYNCH BACK ON THE SIDELINES: The game marks the debut of Bill Lynch as just the ninth DePauw football coach since 1930. Lynch took over in December for the retired Nick Mourouzis who directed DePauw to a 138-87-4 mark in 23 seasons.

Lynch was the head coach at Butler from 1985 through 1989 and compiled a 36-12-3 record. He was the head coach at Division I Ball State from 1995 through 2002 and his teams recorded a 37-53 mark with a Mid-American Conference championship and Las Vegas Bowl appearance in 1996 and a MAC West Division co-title in 2001. His final three teams at Ball State were recognized by the American Football Coaches for outstanding graduation rates. Lynch's last game as head coach came on November 30, 2002, when the Cardinals lost at Marshall by a 38-14 count. His last win was the previous week against Buffalo by a 41-21 score in Muncie.

EVERYBODY'S ALL-AMERICAN: Senior wide receiver and kick returner **Jamarcus Shephard** was selected to every all-America team as a kick returner at the conclusion of last season and was again a consensus preseason all-America pick. Shephard was a Division III first team selection by D3football.com, *Lindy's* and *Street & Smith* as well as a second team choice by *Football Gazette*. Shephard returned 19 kickoffs last season for an average of 34.7 yards including a pair of touchdowns against Millsaps. His average ranked second in Division III. In all, he finished with four returns of 74 or more yards last year and has returned three kickoffs for scores in his career.

CHASING RECORDS: Jamarcus Shephard enters today's game needing just 59 kickoff return yards to break the DePauw record of 1,171 held by Jon Holloway (1994-96). Shephard broke the single-season mark with 659 yards last year. His 2,871 career all-purpose yards rank eighth in school history and he needs 43 to pass Dan Ryan (1999-02), 124 to move ahead of Jamie Cunha (1992-96) and 180 to pass Bart Simpson (1971-74). Terry Dickey (1988-91) is the all-time leader with 5,240.

Shephard enters the season with 121 career pass receptions which ranks 10th in school history. He needs six to pass Jamie Cunha (1992-96) and seven to move ahead of Kevin Perkins (1979-81). His 1,567 receiving yards also rank 10th in school history. He needs 76 to move ahead of John Stephens (1999-02) and 176 to pass former NFL tight end Greg Werner (1985-88).

NOTES: The Tigers last September 4 game came in 1999 when they lost at home to Rhodes by a 33-14 count. Prior to that they lost to Millsaps by a 20-16 score in 1994 before becoming members of the SCAC ... DePauw has won its last three season openers and are 6-4 in their last 10. They are 7-3 in their last 10 season openers that occurred on the road ... Jamarcus Shephard has caught at least two passes in each of his last 20 games, while Brian Culp has hauled in at least one in each of his last 10 ... DePauw was picked second in a preseason poll of SCAC coaches. The Tigers totaled 35 points behind Trinity's 47. Rhodes was next at 34 and Centre fourth with 31 ...
