## Tigers Close SCAC Play with Engineers

DePauw concludes its Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference competition with the final home game of the 2004 season as it hosts Rose-Hulman.

The Tigers have won four straight and enter the contest with a 6-2 overall record and a 4-1 mark in the SCAC. The Engineers are 4-4 overall and 1-3 in the SCAC.

**SCOUTING ROSE-HULMAN**

Rose-Hulman is going after its second straight .500 season after accomplishing the feat with last year's win in Terre Haute. Two of the Engineers' losses this season have come by a total of just 15 points including an overtime loss to Rhodes.

Cameron Hummel and Aaron Gerhardstein have split time at quarterback for the Engineers who are completing 54 percent of their passes. Charlie Key is the team's top rusher with an average of 75.4 yards per game and 4.8 yards per carry. Hummel chips in nearly 46 yards per contest and a team-high 6.0 yards per attempt. Seven different Rose-Hulman players have double-digit reception totals led by Jared Moore with 16 for 151 yards.

Defensively, Jake Vieck and Austin Hastings lead the way with 56 tackles apiece, while Matt Jackson adds 50. Vieck is the team leader with 10 sacks and 17 tackles for loss. He ranks 10th among Division III sacks leaders and 13th in tackles for loss. Brett Beultel ranks third in the nation with 0.9 interceptions per contest and 18th with 1.6 passes defended per game.

**LAST YEAR'S MEETING**

Rose-Hulman took advantage of five DePauw turnovers and defeated the Tigers, 22-12, in Terre Haute. The Tigers jumped out to a 6-0 lead in the first quarter before the Engineers took a 7-6 lead into halftime.

DePauw regained the lead midway through the third, but a pair of Cameron Hummel touchdown runs gave the hosts the win.

Hummel rushed for 128 yards and all three Engineer scores and threw for 235 yards. DePauw quarterback Ross Wiethoff rushed for 74 yards and threw for 107 in a backup role.

The Tigers totaled 427 yards including 201 on the ground but were held to a season-low 12 points. Rose-Hulman finished with 465 yards of offense with 230 coming on the ground.

Defensively, DePauw sacked Hummel four times as Joshua Swift finished with two and Cory Partlow and Eric Lewis each added one. Partlow led the Tigers with 14 tackles including three for losses with Jeremy Legge chipping in 10. Nick Dames paced the Engineers with 12 tackles.

**LYNCH JUST THE NINTH DEPAUW COACH SINCE 1930**

This game marks the ninth of Bill Lynch's DePauw career as just the ninth DePauw football coach since 1930. Lynch took over in December for the retired Nick Mourouzis who directed the Tigers to a 138-87-4 mark in 23 seasons.

Lynch was the head coach at Butler from 1985 through 1989 and compiled a 36-12-3 record. The Bulldogs won four conference titles and advanced to the NCAA Division II playoffs in 1988. He was the head coach at Division I Ball State from 1995 through 2002 and his 1996 team won the Mid-American Conference championship and earned a Las Vegas Bowl appearance. The Cardinals also won the MAC West Division co-title in 2001. His final three teams at Ball State were recognized by the American Football Coaches for outstanding graduation rates.

**DEPAUW IN NATIONAL RANKINGS**

In Division III statistics released earlier this week, Ross Wiethoff ranks eighth in Division III passing efficiency at 163.7. Jamarcus Shephard ranks 18th with a kickoff return average of 26.1 yards and finished second in the nation last year. Shephard ranks 23rd in receiving yards per game with 97.3. Dustin Hertel is 26th in tackles for loss with 1.8 per game. The Tigers are 32nd as a team by allowing just 100.9 rushing yards per game and 34th with 227.2 rushing yards per outing.

**EVERYBODY'S ALL-AMERICAN**

Senior wide receiver and kick returner **Jamarcus Shephard** was selected to every all-America team as a kick returner at the conclusion of last season and was again a consensus preseason all-America pick. Shephard was a Division III first team selection by D3football.com, *Lindy's* and *Street & Smith* as well as a second team choice by *Football Gazette*. Shephard returned 19 kickoffs last season for an average of 34.7 yards including a pair of touchdowns against Millsaps. His average ranked second in Division III. In all, he finished with four returns of 74 or more yards last year and has returned three kickoffs for scores in his career.

**TIGERS ESTABLISH GROUND GAME**

The Tigers have rushed for over 200 yards five times this year and in each of the last three games. The 388 rushing yards against Hope were the third most in school history and the most since they had 389 at Rhodes on September 5, 1998. The school record is 532 yards against Principia on October 11, 1975. The Tigers' 60 rushing attempts against Hope were their most since they had 60 against Blackburn on October 13, 2001. The last time they had more attempts in a game was on November 14, 1998, when they totaled 64 against Wabash.

**TWO TOP 100 YARDS**

Ross Wiethoff and Jeremiah Marks each topped the 100-yard rushing plateau in the Sewanee win and did the same in the victory over Hope. Marks is just the third DePauw player to rush over for 100 yards in three different games as a freshman. Tom Campbell (1955) and Johnathon Stigall (1995) each did it three times, while Sam Juarascio (1972) did it once. Wiethoff has topped the 100-yard mark three times in his career.

**CHASING RECORDS**

Jamarcus Shephard broke the DePauw career record for kickoff return yards in the Hope win and now has 1,374 on 48 returns for an average of 28.6 yards per return. Shephard's 3,904 career all-purpose yards rank second in school history behind Terry Dickey (1988-91) who had 5,240.

Shephard enters the game with 163 career pass receptions which ranks third in school history. He needs 22 to pass Dan Ryan (1999-02). Jay True (1977-80) is the all-time leader with 195. Shephard's 2,345 receiving yards rank fourth in school history and he needs 64 to pass Jamie Cunha (1992-93, 95-96) and 223 to move ahead

of Jay True (1977-80). Dan Ryan (1999-02) is the all-time leader with 2,913.

**TIGERS GOING AFTER WINNING MARK AT BLACKSTOCK**

The Tigers are 2-2 at Blackstock Stadium this year with wins over Hope and Sewanee and losses to Wisconsin-Stout and Trinity. A win over Rose-Hulman would give them a winning home record for the fourth straight year and the eighth time in the last nine years. Since beginning play in the stadium in 1941, the Tigers are 167-122-5 for a .577 winning percentage. DePauw is 14-6 in home SCAC games with four losses coming to Trinity and two to Centre.

**TIGERS TOUGH IN LATE SEASON**

Since beginning SCAC play in 1998, the Tigers have posted a 32-8 record in games played in October and November. They are 15-4 in October and November home games in that time.

**TIGER NOTES**

Jamarcus Shephard has caught at least one pass in each of his last 28 games ... Shephard has totaled 778 receiving yards this year which ranks 12th in school history. He needs six to top his own previous single-season best set last year and 214 to break the record of 991 set by John Stephens in 2001 ... Ross Wiethoff ranks 11th in school history with 1,249 rushing yards and needs 44 to move into 10th ... he ranks eighth with 3,246 total offense yards ... Wiethoff is the first player in DePauw history with at least 1,000 rushing and 1,900 passing yards ... Wiethoff's 277.38 efficiency rating against Centre was the highest known in school history ... Jeremiah Marks' 702 rushing yards this year ranks ninth in school history and he needs 46 to move ahead of Bart Simpson's 747 in 1972 and 72 to pass Terry Dickey's 773 in 1991. Simpson holds the record with 1,009 in 1973 ... fullback Brett Claxton has caught three collegiate passes with the first two going for touchdowns ... DePauw outscores the opposition 98-27 in the second quarter of games and possesses the ball an average of 3:29 longer than its opponents in the fourth quarter ... DePauw has assured itself of its ninth straight .500 or better season which broke the school record previously set from 1980 through 1987 ... the Tigers still have a chance at winning eight games for the first time since 1997 ... DePauw's last five-game win streak came in 2002.
