CREDENTIALS

Media members planning on covering a DePauw game should first contact Bill Wagner, Director of Sports Information at (765) 658-4630. All photographers must restrict their work area to the endlines as NCAA guidelines dictate.

INFORMATION AVAILABLE

Programs, lineups and other pregame information will be provided on press row and in the press box in the upper level of the Neal Fieldhouse prior to each home game. Halftime statistics will be available as will complete play-by-play and final statistics approximately five minutes following the game. All statistics are compiled with the Stat Crew™ system.

TELEPHONES

RADIO COVERAGE

DIRECTIONS TO LILLY CENTER

From Interstate 70: Exit Interstate 70 at Exit 41 (U.S. 231) and proceed north for approximately seven miles. Turn left on Hanna Street (at Pizza King Restaurant) and continue on that for five blocks and turn left on Indiana Street. The Lilly Center will be on your left.

From North U.S. 231: Proceed south on 231 until it turns at the Courthouse Square. Where it turns, proceed straight for five blocks and turn left on Hanna Street and then right on Indiana (the next intersection). The Lilly Center will be on your left.

From Route 240: Follow 240 west to the intersection with U.S. 231. Turn left on 231 for four blocks and then turn right on Hanna Street (at Pizza King Restaurant) and continue for five blocks and turn left on Indiana Street. The Lilly Center will be on your left.
