

## COMM 292/COMM 491 Projects in Communication Policy and Procedures

The Department of Communication and Theatre provides students an opportunity to work with faculty on special projects through the COMM 292 Projects in Communication or COMM 491 Advanced Projects in Communication course. These courses may be completed within any division of the department and with any teaching faculty member of the department. Past course projects have included creative projects, faculty/student research collaborations, and student teaching assistants for department curriculum. In some cases, COMM 491 Projects in Communication can be approved for projects related to the department's co-curricular activities.

The student, in collaboration with a faculty sponsor, who proposes a special project or teaching assistantship, should complete the appropriate Registration Form (see the Department of Communication and Theatre website). The form should be delivered to the department early enough for the approved project to be assigned a specific course letter and forwarded to the Registrar's office for processing.
