- Spouse did not live in the home during the last 6 months of the tax year. The spouse is considered to live in the home even if he or she is temporarily absent due to special circumstances.
- The parent home was the main home of a child, stepchild, or eligible foster child for more than half the year.
- Must be able to claim an exemption for the child.
- 2. The parent paid more than half the cost of keeping up a home for the year.
- 3. A "qualifying person" lived with the parent in the home for more than half the year (except for temporary absences, such as school).
