PORTS OF CALL

SORRENTO/CAPRI, ITALY

Overlooking the breathtaking Bay of Naples, near the legendary ruins of Pompeii, Sorrento delights with cobblestone streets, a seaside promenade and vibrant Southern Italian culture. According to Greek mythology, here was the home of the Sirens, the femmes fatales who lured sailors to rocky shores. Close by, Italy's famed island Capri offers stunning panoramas, charming villages and ancient villas.

AMALFI/POSITANO, ITALY

Situated on the picturesque Amalfi coast is the enchanting town of Amalfi, filled with ancient wonders like the 12th-century Capuchin monastery and the beautiful 11th-century cathedral and cloister. Nearby, clinging to steep slopes above a sparkling bay, Positano charms all who visit with its Moorish-style houses and colorful fishing boats.

CAGLIARI (SARDINIA), ITALY

A delightful old city spread over seven hills, Cagliari's attractions reflect the influence of its numerous rulers. The city's 2,000 years of history is revealed in archaeological remains, Byzantine churches and many fine museums. Nearby is the beach of Il Poetto—perfect for a city-side swim.

TRAPANI (SICILY), ITALY

Perched on a low-lying, palazzi-dotted promontory on Sicily's western coast, Trapani reveals a hint of its medieval past in its historic core's tightly knit maze of narrow streets. Well worth a visit are the rebuilt 13th-century Cathedral of San Lawrence and grandiose 14th-century Sanctuary of the Annunciation, which holds a fascinating regional museum, while the Willa Margherita public gardens make for a relaxing afternoon.

VALLETTA, MALTA

A myriad of cultural layers unravel in Valletta, the scenic capital of Malta. Founded by the Knights of St. John and deemed a UNESCO World Heritage Site as "one of the most concentrated historic areas in the world," the city boasts 16th-century limestone buildings and ancient fortifications.

AGHIOS NIKOLAOS (CRETE), GREECE

For centuries, the beauty of Agios Nikolaos has attracted visitors as a popular getaway. The town's charming harbor and small, picturesque lagoon, Lake Voulismeni, affords a beautiful panorama accented by the town's lovely beaches. The town is also a gateway to Crete's striking natural landscapes dotted with lovely Byzantine villages, quaint windmills and ancient Minoan palaces, including the legendary Palace of Knossos.

SANTORINI, GREECE

Famed for its spectacular sunsets, the island's distinctive crescent shape is the result of an enormous volcanic eruption thousands of years ago. Behold a panorama of indigo-domed churches and chalk-colored homes clinging to stony cliffs along the caldera, black sand beaches dotted with pebbles beside deep, azure waters, and breathtaking rock formations climbing from the volcanic floor— here is the epitome of Grecian beauty.

EPHESUS/KUSADASI, TURKEY

The port of Kusadasi, until recently a fishing and farming village, is today a resort town offering splendid beaches and plenty of shops. Nearby is the legendary ruined city of Ephesus, a veritable museum of Greek and Roman history with impeccably preserved relics from its ancient past. Here you'll find the Library of Celsus, the incredible Terraced Houses, and the remains of the Temple of Artemis—one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World.

SKIATHOS, GREECE

Charming hilltop tavernas, lively nightlife, and a gorgeous setting of emerald-green hills and aquamarine seas make this island in the Northern Sporades truly irresistible. Skiathos also boasts over 50 beaches, including the well-known Koukounariés, an unspoiled natural haven with sweeping golden sands hemmed by fragrant pine trees.

ISTANBUL, TURKEY

Indulge your senses in this magnificent city astride two continents and divided by the Bosphorus. Once known as Constantinople, Istanbul was the capital of both the Byzantine and Ottoman Empire, and is now a fascinating blend of ancient and cosmopolitan—home to the impressive Blue Mosque, Topkapi Palace and the Grand Bazaar.
