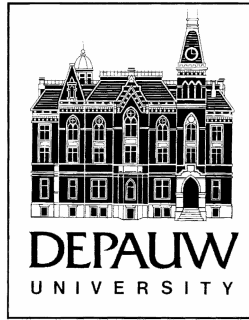

PURPOSE

DePauw University's annual National Undergraduate Honors Conference is designed to encourage undergraduate scholarship and to facilitate interaction between undergraduates and major scholars in communication and theatre. This conference is an outstanding opportunity for beginning researchers to discuss their work with leading scholars.

SUBMISSIONS

We welcome papers from outstanding undergraduates. Papers should represent individual research and deal with any subject falling within the general area of communication and theatre such as rhetoric, interpersonal communication, mass communication, organizational communication, and theatrical history and criticism. Limited multiple authorship is acceptable, but not class projects; we reserve the right to invite only one author. Papers may employ either a critical or behavioral methodology and we particularly encourage diversity in viewpoints and approaches.

EXPENSES

Housing (Thursday to Saturday), meals, and conference materials will be provided for each participant. Cost of transportation to and from the conference must be borne by the participant. A free shuttle service will be provided from the Indianapolis airport to DePauw University. There will be a conference registration fee of \$150 per participant.
