# TSA Travel Guide

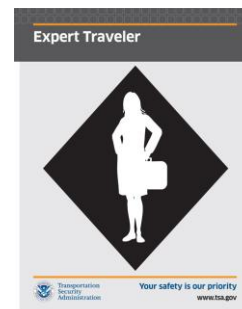


**INDIANAPOLIS** – As students and families around Indianapolis begin their travel during the busy spring break season, the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) is reminding travelers to prepare for security. Passengers should be familiar with security procedures at Indianapolis International Airport in order to streamline their screening experience.

**3 Simple Steps to Security:** 1) Have boarding pass and identification out and reading to present to the travel document checker. 2) Take out liquids (in a baggie) and laptops. 3) Take off shoes and jackets.

**Self-Select Lanes:** At Indianapolis International, TSA has launched the self-select lane program. This allows each traveler to select the screening lane that best meets their travel needs. There are three types of lanes: Family/Medical Liquids Lane, Casual Traveler Lane and Expert Traveler Lane.

The Family/Medical Liquids Lane is intended for families traveling with small children, individuals who need more time to process through security and travelers carrying medically exempt liquids like breast milk, baby formula or insulin that will require additional screening. The Casual Traveler Lane can be used by travelers who are familiar with security procedures but are carrying multiple carry-on items. The Expert Lane is for frequent travelers who have very few carry-on items. Checkpoint signage will direct you to the lane of your choice.



**3-1-1 for Liquids:** Travelers may carry liquids, gels and aerosols in containers of 3 ounces or less in 1 quart-size, clear plastic, zip-top bag through the security checkpoint. Each passenger may bring 1 plastic zip-top bag. Remove the bag from your carry-on and place it in a bin or on the conveyor belt for X-ray screening.

**Remember:** If you are unsure about bringing a particular item in your carry-on or checked baggage, visit [www.tsa.gov](http://www.tsa.gov) for a complete list of prohibited items. Also, give yourself adequate time to check your baggage and move through security and check with your air carrier for any flight delays. Belligerent behavior, inappropriate jokes and threats will not be tolerated. Such incidents will result in delays and possibly missing your flight. Local law enforcement may be called as necessary.
