- Put Public Safety in your cell (765) 658-4261.

- Call DePauw Public Safety IMMEDIATELY at (765) 658-4261 if you observe suspicious activity or if you need to report a crime.
- Never leave your personal property unattended, even for a short amount of time. Complete a personal property inventory sheet (on back of this form) for all items of value, also printable from the Public Safety website. (ex. laptop, cell phone, IPOD, bicycle).
- Familiarize yourself with the locations of the blue light emergency phones.
- Attend or organize a safety talk with a DePauw Public Safety Officer.
- Keep doors shut & locked and keep your key and student ID with you at all times.
- If you have a bicycle on campus utilize bike racks and always remember to lock your bike.
