- Know the number to DePauw Public Safety (765) 658-4261 and store it in your cell phone.
- Sign up for JYNGLE, our emergency notification system, on the Public Safety home page.

- Call DePauw Public Safety IMMEDIATELY if you observe suspicious activity or if you are victimized.
- Never leave your personal property unattended, even for a short amount of time. If there is an opportunity for your property to be taken you should assume that it will be taken. Complete a personal property inventory sheet for all items of value, printable from the Public Safety website. (ex. laptop, cell phone, IPOD, bicycle).
- Familiarize yourself with the locations of the blue light emergency phones.
- Attend or organize a safety talk with a DePauw Public Safety Officer.
- Get into the habit of locking doors and keeping your key and student ID with you at all times.
- If you have a bicycle on campus utilize bike racks and always remember to lock your bike.
