

The Steve & Michelle Trulaske International Scholarship

For study on the AHA-International program in Segovia, Spain

Students planning to study on the MCSA/AHA-International program in Segovia, Spain during the fall 2010 or spring 2011 semesters, or during summer 2010 are invited to apply for the Steve & Michelle Trulaske International Scholarship. Thanks to a gift from a generous DePauw graduate, DePauw is able to support students wishing to study in Segovia for a fall semester, spring semester or summer term. Applications for a scholarship to support a year of study will also be considered.

Eligibility

All students applying to the AHA-International Segovia program are eligible to apply for this scholarship. There will be 10 awards given in the fall semester, 10 awards in the spring semester, and 10 awards in the summer term. Preference for applications to the AHA-International Segovia program will be given to students who

- have never been outside of the USA
- have never been to Spain
- are first generation college students (neither parent attended college)
- have financial need.

Recipients of the Scholarship must be accepted by AHA-International for participation in the Segovia program in Spain for either the summer or semester. Recipients also must take a minimum of three DPU credits per semester when enrolled in the study abroad program. Upon return from Segovia, recipients will be required to write a reflective essay and provide a presentation of his or her experiences to the DePauw community.

Selection Process

The Steve & Michelle Trulaske International Scholarships are awarded by a committee of two faculty members from the Department of Modern Languages and the director of the Center for International and Experiential Education. In considering the applications, the committee will take into account the candidate's need for financial assistance, academic record, and the applicant's motivation for study abroad, in addition to the interest expressed for studying in Segovia. Preference will be given to students who have not had previous opportunities to study abroad.

Taxes

Scholarships that cover anything other than tuition, fees, or books are taxable. Please check with the Financial Aid Office if you have questions.

Application Deadlines

-February 15, 2010: for Fall 2010 and Spring 2011 students

-April 1, 2010: Summer 2010 students

Applications should be submitted by the deadline to the Center for International and Experiential Education, located in the Durham House at 309 E. Seminary Street.
