

Curricular Practical Training (CPT) – Employer Offer Letter Template

Employers: Please use the template below to create an employment offer letter for the DePauw University student to whom your organization is offering an internship. The employment offer should be signed and printed on official letterhead. You are welcome to contact DePauw University's International Student Affairs office with any questions at (765) 658-4850 or intlstudents@depauw.edu.

During an academic semester or official break period, international students are permitted to work off campus only once they have received official work authorization from their universities' international student affairs office. This work authorization, called "Curricular Practical Training" (CPT), allows international students to engage in a practicum or employment off campus in exchange for academic credit, pay or other forms of compensation (free meals, housing, etc.). Applying for CPT is free for international students and employers. However, all days of employment CPT authorization must be obtained prior to the first day of employment. If a student works before or after the dates authorized for CPT, the student's academic program may be terminated, resulting in departure from the United States.
