Choose Two Thematic Tracks to Focus your Major¹

- You must complete three courses at the 300-400 level within your tracks.
 - One track must contain at least two credits at the 300-400 level.
 - The other must contain at least one credits at the 300-400 level.

PLEASE NOTE: To create a strong major for yourself, you should only apply an introductory (100-level) course to your major if it is required as a pre-req for an upper level course you are applying to your major.

Important DePauw Policies

Double majors: If you have two majors, each major must include at least six courses that do not overlap between the two majors.
