F-CAPE - Global French Studies Placement Test Scores Rev 4/23/2019

Compare the computer placement test score you have received with the courses listed below. Your score will tell you which Global French Studies (GFS) course you should take. If you receive a score just below the one required for the next higher level, the Global French Studies Program (GFS) will allow you to choose to move up one level. However, ***you may not*** register for a course that is below the one corresponding to your placement test score.

Important:

- Students at DePauw are required to complete two language courses (in the same language), regardless of placement. The guide below indicates your “starting point” for GFS courses at DePauw.
- Students whose first language is not English may be certified as meeting this requirement through the Office of the Registrar, and in consultation with the director of English for Academic Purposes.

Students who place into the 200- or 300-level of GFS courses and who then take the GFS course recommended and earn a C or better receive additional (retroactive) credits as shown:

440+	GFS 300-level	2 credits (representing two GFS 200-level courses)
355-439	GFS 200-level	1 credit (representing one GFS 200-level course)
275-354	GFS 200-level	(none)
200-274	GFS 110	(none)
0-199	GFS 101	(none)

****If French is the language you normally speak at home, you may NOT register for a GFS 200-level course. You may begin with any GFS 300-level course.****

**** GFS 110 is not open to students with more than two years of French in high school (grades 9-12). With a placement test score of 0-274, these students must begin with GFS 110 (Review of Elementary French). No additional credit is given.****
