

G-CAPE - German Placement Test Scores Rev 8/21/26

Compare the computer placement test score you have received with the courses listed below. This will indicate which German course should be taken. If you receive a score just below the one required for the next higher level, we will allow you to choose to move up one level. However, you may **not** register for a course that is below the one corresponding to your placement test score.

Important:

- Students at DePauw are required to complete two language courses (in the same language), regardless of placement. The guide below indicates your “starting point” for GRMN courses.
- Students whose first language is not English may be certified as meeting this requirement through the Office of the Registrar, and in consultation with the director of English for Academic Purposes.

Students who place into the 212 or 300-level of GRMN courses and who then take the GRMN course recommended and earn a C or better receive additional (retroactive) credits as shown. Retroactive credits do not count toward the language requirement.

****NOTE:** GRMN 111 not open to students with more than **two** years of German in high school (grades 9-12). These students must take **GRMN 112** (Elementary German II), regardless of the score received. No additional credit is available.
