A resolution requesting the Lilly Center and Welch Fitness Center offer nutritious vending machine options to promote the health and well-being of their faculty and students.

Resolution No. 6

WHEREAS, the current hours of the Lilly Center and Welch Fitness Center are from Sunday 8am-12pm, Monday-Thursday 6am-12pm, Friday 6am-11pm, and Saturday 8am-11pm.

WHEREAS, the current hours of The Blend in the Lilly Center and Welch Fitness Center are from Monday-Friday 8am-5pm, while the fitness center is open much later.

WHEREAS, the Longden Café hours are from Monday-Sunday 4pm-11:45pm, and not always fully stocked with food and drink items that build muscle, improve endurance, and promote a speedy recovery after a workout. Additionally, it should be noted that these hours are subject to change once the Den convenience store is moved to the Hub next year. Furthermore, once the convenience store moves to the Hub, there will no longer be food and drink items available on the south end of campus.

WHEREAS, the students and faculty of DePauw University exercise in the Lilly Center and Welch Fitness Center at all hours of operation, and there are times throughout the week, especially on the weekends, when sufficient nutrition is not available for purchase to recharge after physical activity.

WHEREAS, many other universities offer convenient 24/7 access to nutritious options such as protein bars, protein shakes, granola bars, gatorade, etc. throughout the week through higher-end vending machines.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

that DePauw should place quality vending machines in the Lilly Center and Welch Fitness Center that offer faculty, staff, and students nutritious options that will help those exercising recharge their bodies after rigorous physical training.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

that because many members of the DePauw community have university meal plans, it is proposed that these vending machines be available for these individuals to purchase items using flex dollars and/or meal swipes in addition to using regular cash, cards, and coins.
