RP provided an overview of the plan and answered questions.

Most optimistic timeline is starting construction in May and worst case scenario is starting the year after.

Prevo Science Library will become our central hub during construction. Space is lost, but all services will continue (albeit dispersed). One to two years to complete the renovation. Depends on the details of the renovation.

RP showed us views of new building. West façade redone. Reading room. Terrace over the reading room.

Lower level now has Café Roy and Archives by West entrance. Thoroughfare and tech services.

First floor has event space, Reading Room, and Tenzer Technology Center.

Second floor has a variety of labs, many study rooms, FITS, carrels.

Currently, 15 carrels, different levels of use, only a few intense users, so that will change to a dedicated, flexible faculty space.

Third floor remains heavy on stacks, more study rooms, table areas. Exit to terrace. Culture of quiet. Heavy on books and studying.

Outlet per seat.

Tenzer Center Director search starts in spring. Goal is student access to technology.

Could move IT Help to the library. That is unclear.

Committed to \$17/\$18 million renovation and we will wait until we have it.
